## What a Study They Must Have Had!

During my ministry years up North, I told someone who only attended occasionally that he had missed a guest speaker the week before. Expressing dismay, he said, "If I had known, I would have come." I reminded him that if God's Word was being preached, then it didn't matter who was presenting it. But I get it. Some speakers are better able to make "our hearts burn within us." This is one reason why our summer series has been so popular the past few years.

What an incredible Bible study Luke 24 records that occurred the "very day" the Word Incarnate was resurrected! Not knowing who their speaker was as they were kept from recognizing Jesus until later, two disciples heard the Word Incarnate, the Master Teacher, expound from the "living and active" Word of God. The account says, "*And beginning with Moses and all the Prophets, he interpreted to them in all the Scriptures the things concerning himself.*" It was only seven miles to Emmaus; no wonder it was "toward evening" when they arrived.

And by this verse, Jesus, the Second Person of the Godhead, the one through whom all things were made (John 1:3) and who had all authority (Matthew 28:18), attests that Moses indeed was God's servant who recorded the inspired Law and that the prophets were sent by God and inspired to preserve their writing, not just for their audience then but for us today: "*For whatever was written in former days was written for our instruction, that through endurance and through the encouragement of the Scriptures we might have hope*" (Romans 15:4).

So ... Jesus puts His seal of approval on the 39 books that make up the Old Testament (the Apocrypha didn't make the canon) as we have it today. They were what Jesus and His followers used exclusively in the 1st Century to proclaim the gospel. And they deepen our understanding while motivating us to persevere.

Jesus Himself may not open those same Old Testament Scriptures to us, but we can have an incredible study that begins with belief that they are truth.
