- Luke 14:7ff the humble will be exalted
- Positive aspects of humility
  - Acts 18:24 Apollos was well-versed, and accepted help and guidance. He could admit when he was wrong.
  - Matt 7:1-5 if we are not humble, we cannot help others effectively. We cannot act like we're better than others.
  - Gal 2:11ff Paul confronted Peter. Peter accepted the correction.
  - 2 Cor 11:7ff some situations make us humble and more strong
