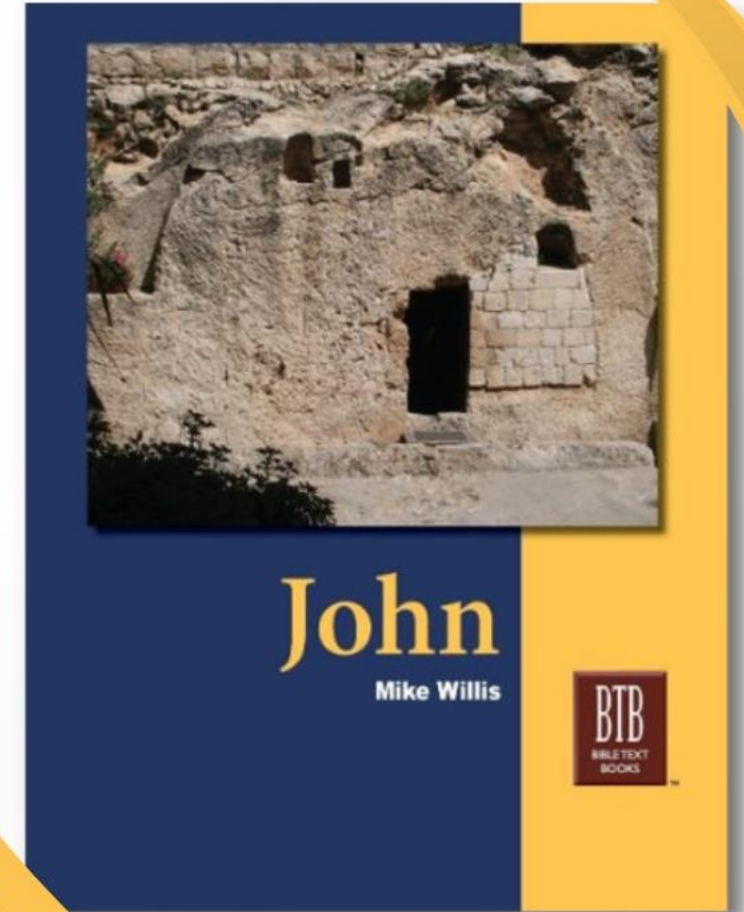


Lesson 8

Christ's Ministry to the World (6:1-71)



The Feeding of the Five Thousand (6:1-15)

- A. Jesus followed by a great multitude (6:1-4)
- B. Jesus asks Philip a question (6:5-7).
- C. Andrew finds a lad with 5 barley loaves and 2 small fishes (6:8-9).
- D. Jesus instructions to his disciples (6:10).
- E. Jesus blesses the food and gives to his disciples and they distributed to the people, until all were filled. Jesus departs. (6:11-15).

Jesus walks on the water (6:16-21)

- A. Jesus sends his disciples away (6:16-17)
- B. Jesus departed to the mountain alone (6:15).
- C. Disciples on sea at night about 3-4 miles from Tiberias' area, during storm. (6:19).
- D. Jesus walks on the sea to the boat. (6:19).
- E. Jesus tells them not to be afraid and as soon as they receive Him the boat immediately arrives at the Capernaum area (approx 6-7 miles distance from their current position) (6:20-21).

Jesus the Bread of Life(6:22-59)

- A. The next morning the people discover that Jesus is missing, so they depart and find Him in Capernaum (6:22-25)
- B. Jesus identifies the real reason they seek Him (6:26-27).
- C. The people ask for a sign. (6:30-31)
- D. Jesus identifies the true bread from heaven (6:32-40).

Jesus the Bread of Life(6:22-59)

- E. Jesus is rejected for saying He is the bread which came down from heaven (6:41-42)
- F. Jesus explains that no one comes to Him unless first drawn by the Word of God (6:43-45)
- G. Jesus explains that He has seen the Father and he that believes in Me hath everlasting life. That He is the living bread and will give his flesh for the life of the world (6:46-51)

Jesus the Bread of Life(6:22-59)

- H. The Jews do not understand how Jesus will give them His flesh to eat. (6:52)
- I. Jesus explains and teaches in the synagogue that one must eat My flesh and drink My blood in order to have eternal life. (6:53-59)

The Crowd's Reaction (6:60-71)

- A. Many of those who had come from Bethsaida rejected this saying of Jesus (6:60-63)
- B. Jesus acknowledges their unbelief (6:64-65).
- C. Many disciples left Him at this point (6:66)
- D. Jesus asks his disciples that he had chosen, if they too wanted to go away (6:67-69).
- E. Jesus answered them that He had chosen them, but one is a devil. (Judas) (6:70-71)
