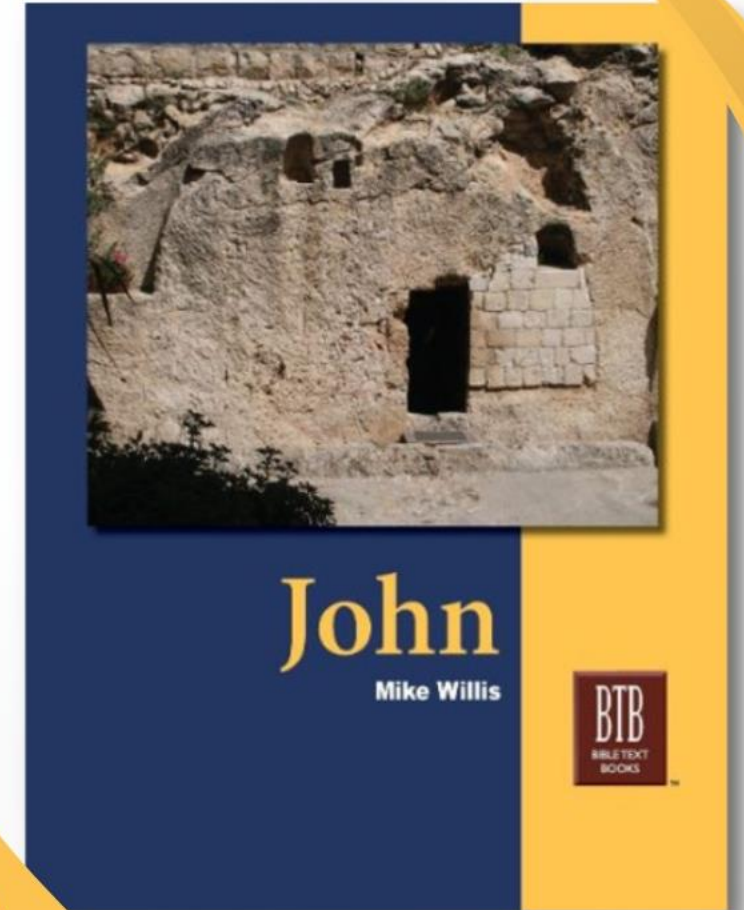


Lesson 16

I. Jesus, the Way to the Father (14:1-13)

1. “Let not your heart be troubled” (vv. 1-4).
 - a. There are many “dwelling places” (NASB) in His Father’s House (vv. 1-2).
 - b. He is going to prepare a place for them (vv. 3-4).

I. Jesus, the Way to the Father (14:1-13)

1. “Let not your heart be troubled” (vv. 1-4).
2. Jesus is the only means to fellowship with the Father (vv. 5-14).
 - a. Jesus is the only way to fellowship with the Father (vv. 5-7).
 - b. Jesus is in the Father, and the Father is in Jesus (vv. 8-11).
 - c. Belief in Jesus will lead to success in their ministry, and glory to the Father (vv. 12-14).

II. The Promise of the Holy Spirit (vv. 15-31)

1. Jesus promises to send them another Comforter (vv. 15-18).
2. Jesus tells of His imminent departure (vv. 19-24).
3. The work of the Holy Spirit (vv. 25-26).
4. Jesus promises them peace (vv. 27-31).
