- Peter's message, Jesus is Lord (2:22-36)
- The reaction and response to the message (2:37-47)

Acts 2 is a culminating point in Luke's message

- Jesus would baptize with the Holy Spirit (Luke 3:15-17)
- This was a promise that the apostles would receive in Jerusalem (Luke 24:49 and Acts 1:5-8)
