- A. She prayed for a child and then lent him to the Lord for life. (Hannah - Samuel, Elkanah) **1 Sam. 1:1, 28**
- B. He committed the first murder. (Cain - Abel) **Gen. 4:8**
- C. He was king over Israel after David. (Solomon) **1 Kings 1:39**
- D. He was commanded to offer his son as a sacrifice. (Abraham - Isaac) **Gen. 22:1, 2**
- E. He led Israel out of Egypt. (Moses) **Ex. 12:31**
- F. He was Jesse's most famous son. (David) **1 Sam. 16:7, 13**
- G. He used a stone for a pillow and dreamed of a ladder that reached to heaven. (Jacob) **Gen. 28:11, 12**
- H. He was the son of Zacharias and Elizabeth. (John the Baptist) **Luke 1:13**
- I. They died because they lied about giving. (Ananias and Sapphira) **Acts 5:1, 2, 5, 10**
- J. He went with Paul on his first missionary journey. (Barnabas) **Acts 13:2, 9**
