JESUS IN THE HOUSE

Mark 2:1-12

INTRO:

1. We can learn from miracles He performed.
2. God recorded what he did to help our faith.

John 20:30, 31

I. JESUS WANTS TO COME INTO EVERY HOUSE.

- A. There is not a home represented here today that Jesus does not want to enter. **Rev. 3:20; Luke 19:5**
- B. Is he invited into our homes? **Luke 24:29**

II. JESUS FILLS THE HOUSE WHEN HE COMES IN.

Mark 2:1, 2

- A. He brings friends. **Gal. 5:22, 23; Matt. 19:29**
- B. Some houses, and hearts, are empty today simply because they have not allowed Jesus to come in.

III. WHEN JESUS IS IN THE HOUSE, HE CANNOT BE HIDDEN. **Mark 1:1; Mark 7:24; Acts 4:13**

IV. SOMETIMES THOSE THAT COME TO CHRIST MEET DIFFICULTY. **Mark 2:3, 4**

- A. There was a crowd of hearers around the door. **Matt. 23:13; James 1:22**
- B. The men in our text were determined and did not let the crowd stop them.

V. SOME WILL ONLY COME IF THEY ARE BROUGHT. **Mark 2:3,4**

- A. This helpless man never would have made it had it not been for his friends. **John 1:41, 42**
- C. We sing about bringing them in from the fields of sin, but how hard do we try?

VI. WHEN JESUS COMES IN AND HEALS US, THE RESULTS ARE UNMISTAKABLE.

- A. No one is the same after coming in contact with Christ. **2Cor. 5:17**
- B. The bed on the back of this man was evidence that he had been healed. **2 Cor. 9:8**

CONC:

1. Open the door and let Jesus in the house.
2. Then bring others to know him.
