INTRO:

1. "We will never get out of this world alive."
Josh. 23:14
2. Sir Edmund Hillary at the age of 33 stood on top of the world. At 88, he died.
3. Every physical accomplishment falls against the background of eternity.

I. WHAT IS THE HIGH POINT OF MY LIFE?

- A. I will never stand on top of Mt. Everest, but I've had my highs.
- B. I've always thought it was so sad to hear adults talk of their glory days being long since gone.
- C. I would like everyone to achieve their dreams as long as they are not in opposition to God's will.

II. WE HAVE AN APPOINTMENT THAT CANNOT BE AVOIDED.

- A. Everyone dies. **1 Cor. 15:22; Heb. 9:27**
- B. Father time has only lost two times in all the history of humanity.
- C. We do not know when that day will arrive. **James 4:14**
- D. Christians have an assurance from God that we can be okay. **Psalms 73:24**

CONC:

1. For the child of God, death may take me out of this life, but I can be victorious over it regardless. **1 Cor. 15:25, 26**
2. Milton: "Death is the golden key that opens the door to eternity."
