John 14:27

INTRO:

1. As Christians, we have been sent into the world with the good news. **Matt. 28:18-20**
2. That is a daunting task and can be a bit scary.
3. We all experience stage fright, but we must overcome true fear because it is not from God. **2 Tim. 1:7**

I. JESUS AND HIS APOSTLES.

- A. When he challenged them to become his apostles he told them to not fear. **Luke 5:9-11**
- B. When He sent them out on what we sometimes call the limited commission He said to not be afraid. **Matt. 10:28**
- C. While talking to them about His departure, He Reminded them to not be afraid. **John 14:27**

II. FEAR SEEMS TO BE A PART OF HUMAN NATURE.

- A. There is much about this life that we fear.

 2. Family concerns.
 3. Job stability.
 4. Loneliness.
- B. Remember that our father is the God of all comfort. **2 Cor. 1:3, 4**
- C. Please don't forget that He wants what is best for you.

CONC:

1. God will never leave you or forsake you. **Heb.13:5**
2. Remember that we have an Advocate with the Father. **1 John 2:1, 2**
3. We can cast all of our cares on Him, knowing that He cares for us. **1 Pet. 5:7**
4. Please don't forget that there is nothing that impossible with God and that He is greater than any concerns that come upon us. **Luke1:37; 18:27; 1 John 4:4**
