One Must Seek God

- **The Three Examples**

- **Already Serving, Obviously Interested**

Acts 2:5 (Exod. 23:14-17); Acts 8:27; 10:1, 2

- **God Knew**

Acts 8:26, 28; 10:3-6



One Must Seek God

- **Conversion Demands Interest and Effort**

- **God Has Already Revealed Himself**

Rom. 1:19, 20; 2nd Tim. 3:16; Gen. 1:1; Job 34:14, 15; 2nd Tim. 1:9

- **We Must Seek Him!**

Acts 17:26, 27; Jeremiah 29:13



One Must Hear & Understand

- **The Three Examples**
 - **All Heard or Read the Word**

Acts 2:37; Acts 8:28-30; 11:14
 - **They Needed Outside Help to Understand**

Acts 8:31; 10:6, 33



One Must Hear & Understand

- **Conversion Demands Hearing & Understanding**

- **Faith Comes by Hearing**

Romans 10:17; Titus 1:3; Romans 1:16

- **The Need for Understanding**

Matthew 13:19; Ephesians 5:17



Jesus Must Be Preached

- **The Three Examples**

- **Jesus Was the Central Message**

Acts 2:22-36; Acts 8:35; 10:36-43

- **More Than Just Being the Son of God**

Acts 8:35, 36; Mark 16:15, 16



Jesus Must Be Preached

- **Conversion Demands Knowing Jesus**

- We Must Know Him to Believe in Him

Romans 10:14; John 8:24

- The Gospel's Core Message

Romans 1:16; 1st Corinthians 15:1-3



One Must Believe & Be Baptized

- **The Three Examples**

- **Questions Were Asked and Answered**

Acts 2:37, 38; Acts 8:36-38; 10:43, 47-48

- **All Were Baptized Immediately**

Acts 2:41; 8:38; 10:47, 48



One Must Believe & Be Baptized

- **Conversion Demands Belief & Baptism**

- **Jesus Said As Much**

Mark 16:15, 16

- **A Consistent Message**

Acts 2:38; 8:36-38; 10:47, 48
