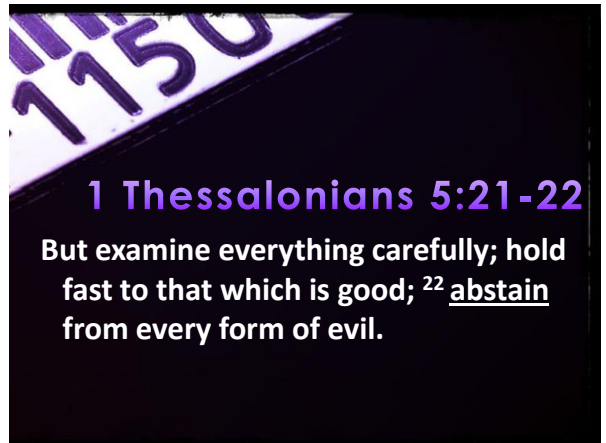



A. It Is A Command (Isaiah 1:16-20)






