1) Jesus Conquered Death

Acts 17:30-31 - "God is now declaring to men that all *people* everywhere should repent"

2) Jesus Conquered Sin

- A. **Sin Enslaves Us** (2 Timothy 2:23-26)
- B. **Remember Your Earthly Ways** (Romans 6:11-23)
- C. **He Delivered Us** (Colossians 1:13-14)

Notes:

Matthew 10:32-33 - "Therefore everyone who confesses Me before men, I will also confess him before My Father who is in heaven."

3) Jesus Conquered The Devil

- A. **Who Sways This World?** (1 John 5:19; Ephesians 6:12)
- B. **Remember When You Have Been Deceived** (2 Corinthians 11:14; 1 Peter 5:8)
- C. **He Defeated The Devil For Us** (Hebrews 2:14; 1 John 3:8; Colossians 2:15)

Notes:

Mark 16:16 - "He who has believed and has been baptized shall be saved; but he who has disbelieved shall be condemned."

What must I do to be saved?

Hear: Romans 10:17, Acts 2:37. **Believe:** Hebrews 11:6, Acts 18:8. **Repent:** Matthew 4:17, Acts 17:30-31. **Confess:** Mat. 10:32-33, John 11:25-27. **Be Baptized:** Mat. 28:19, Acts 2:38, 1 Peter 3:21.
