

Live Streaming Information

Our live streaming events will be posted to our Facebook page. You can easily find our page by searching for @SouthBumby, or simply going to the URL <https://www.facebook.com/SouthBumby/>. If you have a Facebook account, you can “like” that page and you will be informed of messages posted there or live streams that start.

Our worship service during this period will generally conform to the following sequence:

- 10:45 – 11:00: gathering, hopefully with some recorded hymns playing. This is a time for people to connect to the live stream before the worship period begins.
- 11:00: the worship service will start. Generally, the worship service will proceed as follows:
 - Welcome and announcements.
 - Opening Song
 - Prayer
 - Song before the Lord’s supper
 - Lord’s supper talk
 - Lord’s supper served – have your elements at hand so you can partake together with all others who are in the live stream.
 - Contribution – while it won’t be possible with this medium, a prayer, and instructions on how to contribute will be presented.
 - Song before the lesson
 - Sermon
 - Closing song
 - Closing remarks
 - Closing prayer
- The stream will then end. The duration of our streaming service, like our normal services, will vary from meeting to meeting. But will generally be about 1 hour in length.

Matthew Bible Class

We will be continuing our auditorium bible study in Matthew via the Zoom web conference application. Zoom will allow you to see slides, hear the speaker, and participate in the class by making comments or asking questions. Zoom is available on Windows, Linux, and MAC desktop operating systems, as well as the Apple and Android smart phone platforms. You will be prompted to install the desktop client the first time you attempt to join a meeting. For smart phone or tablets you will need to install the Zoom app, which you can find in your App store. To make things smoother, you should plan to join the meeting 15 minutes prior to the class start to work through any installation issues you may encounter. You can also join by telephone but won't be able to see the slides and will have limited ability to participate in the discussion.

All bible classes Zoom meetings will start 15 minutes before the class is scheduled to start. This will give you time to acquaint yourself with Zoom and the options you have for participating. In the client you will have the ability to mute and unmute yourself, turn on or turn off video of yourself, raise and lower your "hand", and add comments to chat. Use these 15 minutes before class to familiarize yourself with these abilities. There is a special sort of etiquette to online meeting such as this:

- Always keep yourself muted, unless you intend to speak. When in a class, please refrain from speaking without first receiving instructions to do so by the teacher. Unmuted mics will often distract (barking dogs and other background noises) and can also introduce feedback.
- Don't enable video unless you REALLY need to. Video also can be a distraction and can be a burden to the network and the quality of the slides and audio everyone sees and hears may suffer.
- Chat messages are preferred to raising your hand to offer a comment or asking a question when there are a large number of people in the meeting, such as during a class.
