Where Is Your Hope Set?

In 1 Timothy 6:17, Paul told Timothy, *“As for the rich in this present age, charge them not to be haughty, nor to set their hopes on the uncertainty of riches, but on God, who richly provides us with everything to enjoy.”* Many people put all of their stock in material possessions. They will spend their entire lives working themselves to the bone to get temporary satisfaction in life. Paul tells Timothy it is foolish to set all of one’s hope on the uncertainty of riches. It is best to set our hope on God. He will provide us with everything we need (Matt. 6:25-26).

How are you trying to fulfill your life and reach that happiness for which you are

striving? The worldly believe this hope will be fulfilled in this life. Thus, their lives are marked by chasing after the things of the world. This often leads them to choose a life of sin and immorality. However, the only hope that can truly satisfy our desires is found in Jesus Christ.
