- 4) Take a look at the beatitudes in Matthew 5:1-16. Do you notice anything similar about the descriptions of the people that are so blessed and fulfilled by God's gifts? Is this a lot that the world would label as "happy"?
- 5) Growth often occurs over a long period of time with tiny changes adding up to a larger change. What is one small way you plan to dwell daily in the deep assurance of God's love so that His voice is the loudest in your life?
