## **“Four Simple Questions”**

1. What Kind of Dirt Are You? Luke 8:14-15 - NKJV  
*14 Now the ones that fell among thorns are those who, when they have heard, go out and are choked with cares, riches, and pleasures of life, and bring no fruit to maturity.  
15 But the ones that fell on the good ground are those who, having heard the word with a noble and good heart, keep it and bear fruit with patience.*
2. Do You Weary or Esteem Those Who Labor Among You?  
I Thessalonians 5:12-13 - NKJV  
*12 And we urge you, brethren, to recognize those who labor among you, and are over you in the Lord and admonish you,  
13 and to esteem them very highly in love for their work's sake. Be at peace among yourselves.*
3. Are You Happy or Offended When You Are Warned?  
I Thessalonians 5:14 - NKJV  
*14 Now we exhort you, brethren, warn those who are unruly, comfort the fainthearted, uphold the weak, be patient with all.*
4. Do You Render Insulting Words When Your Error Is Challenged Or Do You Pursue What Is Good For All? I Thessalonians 5:15 - NKJV  
*15 See that no one renders evil for evil to anyone, but always pursue what is good both for yourselves and for all.*

**How you answer the last three questions is how you answer the first!**

*"...do you not know that friendship with the world is enmity with God? Whoever therefore wants to be a friend of the world makes himself an enemy of God" (Jas. 4:4)*

- \*It takes 70 hours, 40 minutes to read the Bible at pulpit rate.
- \* It takes 52 hours, 20minutes to read the Old Testament.
- \*18 hours, 20 minutes to read the New Testament.
- \*It takes 4 hours, 28 minutes to read the longest section in the Old Testament, Psalms.
- \*It takes 2 hours, 43 minutes to read the longest book in the New Testament, Luke.
- \*It takes 2 months and 10 days to read the entire Bible at the rate of 1 hour a day.
- \* It takes 1 year to read the Bible 5 times and be one-third of the way through the 6th time.
