- I. Sin doesn't work with \_\_\_\_\_. (Habakkuk 1.13; Isaiah 59.1-2; 1 John 1.5-6)
  - A. His sovereignty and holiness. (Genesis 3.22-24; Exodus 3.5; 28.36; Leviticus 10.3; Numbers 20.12; Isaiah 6.3; Revelation 4.8)
  - B. His spiritual nature (John 4.24) vs. the carnality of sin. (1 John 2.15-17; Ephesians 2.1-3)
- II. Sin doesn't work with \_\_\_\_\_.
  - A. Spiritual capacity → fellowship with God. (Genesis 1.27; 3.8a; Ecclesiastes 3.11, 14; 7.29)
  - B. Conscience → “ought/ought not.” (Genesis 3.8b; Proverbs 28.1; Romans 2.14-15; 7.21-23)
- III. Sin doesn't work with \_\_\_\_\_.
  - A. Sin affects relationships. (Genesis 3.12; 4.5, 8; 6.5, 11)
  - B. Consequences of rejecting God. (Romans 1.28-31; 1 Corinthians 6.9-10; Titus 3.3)
- IV. Conclusion. (Romans 6.23)
  - A. And we are all guilty. (Romans 3.23)
  - B. By God's grace and mercy, a solution was offered and persists. (Luke 5.32; Acts 2.36-38)
