3. How did Peter's error (recorded in Galatians 2) affect those around him?

**Read Acts 16.1-4; 1Corinthians 9.19-23; 10.31-11.1**

4. Describe the principle Paul operates under in order to save some.
5. Does Paul place any qualifiers or limitations on this principle?

**Read Romans 14-15.7**

6. Summarize how Paul wants these Christians in Rome to behave toward each other.
7. What are some key guiding principles from the passage that help you to navigate sensitive issues of conscience among other people?
