- **Needed Attitudes:**

- Recognize the Bible for what it is.

2 Timothy 3:16

- An earnest desire.

Psalm 1:1-3; 119:97

- The Bible CAN be understood.

Ephesians 3:4

- It takes time and patience.

2 Timothy 2:15; 2 Peter 3:16; Acts 17:11

How To Study Your Bible:

2 Timothy 2:15

- How To Understand the Text:
 - Need the right approach.
[2 Timothy 3:16] Hebrews 4:12-13
 - Asking and looking:
 - What do I and what don't I understand?
 - Ask while I'm reading:
 - Who is speaking?
 - To whom are they speaking?
 - What is being said?
 - Why is it being said?

How To Study Your Bible:

2 Timothy 2:15

- How To Understand the Text:
 - On what is being said, look for:
 - God Telling me something directly
Mark 16:16
 - God showing me something He approves of **Acts 20:7**
 - And for when God is telling me to take the hint **Hebrews 10:25**
 - An example **Acts 8:27-35**
