 - The Apostles continued in teaching it
Acts 2:42; 1 Cor. 11:23
 - Christians have kept it
Acts 2:42, 20:7; 1 Cor. 11:20

THE LORD'S SUPPER:

- The significance of such a supper:
 - The Fruit of the Vine
Matt. 26:27-29; Heb. 9:15-22
 - The Bread
1 Cor. 11:23-24; Luke 22:19
 - It is a weekly reminder of the great sacrifice and a time of personal reflection. **1 Cor. 11:27-32**
