Keep Away:

2 Thess. 3:6-18

- **Keep Away from the Undisciplined (2 Thess. 3:6-13):**
 - **The command of church discipline. V.6**
 - **Walks in an unruly manner. 1 Jn. 1:6-7**
 - **Paul's example. 2 Thess. 3:7-13**
 - **Worked, provided for his own.**
 - **Some at Thessalonica. vv.10-11**
 - **They're admonished. V.12**

Keep Away:

2 Thess. 3:6-18

- **Keep Away from the Disobedient (2 Thess. 3:14):**
 - **We've moved far beyond Matthew 18:15-20.**
 - **Admonished publicly through this letter.**
 - **Repent or be marked and shunned.**

Keep Away:

2 Thess. 3:6-18

- Admonish Him as a Brother (**2 Thess. 3:15**):
 - Reminder – discipline does not mean they are now enemies. **v.15**
 - The goal of discipline is *correction*.
Heb. 12:11
 - The heart of discipline is *love*.
