The Sword Shall Not Depart:

2 Sam. 12:9-12

- **The Consequences of Sin:**
 - **David seeks and receives forgiveness.**
2 Sam. 12:12-13
 - **However, David cannot undo his actions.**
2 Sam. 12:9
 - **David's sin didn't just impact David.**
2 Sam. 12:9-14
 - **While forgiven, David must now face the consequences of his actions.** **2 Sam. 12:10**

The Sword Shall Not Depart:

2 Sam. 12:9-12

- **The Sword Does Not Depart from David:**
 - **David's sons Ammon, Absalom, and Adonijah all die by the sword (2 Sam. 13:28-29; 18:15; 1 Kings 2:25).**
 - **Absalom rebels against David and publicly lies with his father's concubines (2 Sam. 16:15-16, 22).**
 - **Another civil war breaks out (2 Sam. 20:1-2, 21-22).**

The Sword Shall Not Depart:

2 Sam. 12:9-12

- **What Do We Learn from This?**
 - **We can be forgiven but that does not mean there won't be ripple effects in this life. Gal. 6:7-8**
 - **Past sins do not define you. 1 Tim. 1:13-14**
