- Instructions concerning the land, 6:10-19
- Fathers were to teach their children to love God and keep His commands, 6:20-25

# DEUTERONOMY

- Israel is commanded to utterly destroy the nations of the land, 7:1-6
- Israel was to remain holy to the LORD because they had been chosen by His love to be His people, 7:7-11
- The Blessings of obedience are listed, 7:12-16

# DEUTERONOMY

- The Blessings of obedience to God's command to utterly destroy the nations are listed, 7:12-16
- It was God who would give them the victory over these nations, they should not fear them but the LORD alone, 7:17-26

# DEUTERONOMY

- Israel is reminded of God's care for them in the wilderness as proof of His future care, 8:1-10
- Israel is warned not to forget the LORD once they have enjoyed the blessings of the land because their pride would be their destruction, 8:11-20

# DEUTERONOMY

## Applications

- Ch 7: Fear God and not man
- Ch 8: Remember that it is God who provides for us



# DEUTERONOMY

- Israel is warned against becoming self-righteous before the LORD, 9:1-5
- Israel is reminded of how they had formerly provoked God's anger by their stubbornness, 9:6-14
- Moses reminds Israel that he interceded for them with God, 9:15-21

# DEUTERONOMY

- Israel is reminded of their rebellion by not entering the land at God's command, 9:22-24
- Moses again tells of how he interceded for them with God, 9:25-29
