DEUTERONOMY

- Israel is reminded of God's care for them in the wilderness as proof of His future care, 8:1-10
- Israel is warned not to forget the LORD once they have enjoyed the blessings of the land because their pride would be their destruction, 8:11-20

DEUTERONOMY

Applications

- Ch 8: Remember that it is God who provides for us

DEUTERONOMY

- Israel is warned against becoming self-righteous before the LORD, 9:1-5
- Israel is reminded of how they had formerly provoked God's anger by their stubbornness, 9:6-14
- Moses reminds Israel that he interceded for them with God, 9:15-21

DEUTERONOMY

- Israel is reminded of their rebellion by not entering the land at God's command, 9:22-24
- Moses again tells of how he interceded for them with God, 9:25-29

DEUTERONOMY

Applications

- Ch 8: Remember that it is God who provides for us
- Ch 9: Do not test God by stubborn rebellion

DEUTERONOMY

- Moses recounts the second giving of the law and the making of the second stone tablets that took place in Exodus 34:1-4, 10:1-5
- Aaron's death is recounted and God's command to Levi to carry the ark and serve Him removing them from having an inheritance, 10:6-9

DEUTERONOMY

- Moses reminds Israel of what God's will was for them; that they should fear God and walk in His ways, 10:10-22

- Ch 10: Fear God and keep His commands
