# DEUTERONOMY

- Next Moses prohibits any defective sacrifices to the Lord, 17:1
- If any Israelite transgresses God's covenant, and it is proven by investigation, they were to be put to death, 17:2-7

# DEUTERONOMY

- If the people could not judge how to uphold justice in a given case they were to go to the Levite or a judge for the verdict, 17:8-13
- Moses gives commands regarding Kings and their rule over the people, 17:14-20

# DEUTERONOMY

## Applications

- Ch 17: God's people were to not turn aside from Him in their hearts.

# DEUTERONOMY

- Moses gives laws to protect and provide for the Levites among the people, 18:1-8
- The people were to keep themselves from adopting any religious practices of the people of the land, 18:9-14

# DEUTERONOMY

- God promises to raise up prophets after Moses that will speak His word to the people, 18:15-19
- Moses warns that prophets who speak things not sent by God were to be put to death, 18:20-22

# DEUTERONOMY

## Applications

- Ch 17: God's people were to not turn aside from Him in their hearts.
- Ch 18: God's people are not to imitate the world, but worship as God commands.

# DEUTERONOMY

- God commands that three more cities of refuge be constructed in Israel to provide a place for the manslayer to atone for his sin, 19:1-7
- God makes provision for more cities of refuge if Israel's borders are enlarged by His blessings, 19:8-10



# DEUTERONOMY

- If a man committed murder and sought to abuse the city of refuge then the people were to put him to death, 19:11-13
- God commands that the people not try to acquire land that is not their own by moving a boundary marker, 19:14

# DEUTERONOMY

- The people were not to accept one witness against another man, but only by two or three witnesses could someone be accused, 19:15-20
- God's law required that the compensation for injury could not exceed the damage incurred, 19:21

- Ch 17: God's people were to not turn aside from Him in their hearts.
- Ch 18: God's people are not to imitate the world, but worship as God commands.
- Ch 19: God's people were not to pervert justice or be wrathful in its execution.
