- Laws regarding assisting a neighbor, 22:1-4
- God forbids transvestism as an abomination, 22:5
- God gives laws concerning the mixing of certain items, and of how to craft clothing, 22:9-12
- God gives commands on morality and sexual sin, 22:13-30

# DEUTERONOMY

## Practical Laws 22-26

- God gives commands regarding those not allowed in the worship assembly of Israel, 23:1-8
- God gives commands regarding the purity of the war camp, 23:9-14
- God gives commands regarding escaped slaves and prostitutes, 23:15-18
- God gives commands for lending to foreigners and making vows, 23:19-25



# DEUTERONOMY

## Practical Laws 22-26

- God gives commands regarding marriage, divorce, and remarriage, 24:1-5
- God gives commands regarding millstones, kidnapping, leprosy, and pledges/loans, 24:6-13
- God gives commands protecting the poor laborer, individual responsibility for sin, and laws protecting resident aliens, widows, and orphans, 24:14-23

# DEUTERONOMY

## Practical Laws 22-26

- God commands how to handle legal disputes and punishments, and how to handle an ox, 25:1-4
- God gives commands for handling Levirate Marriage, 25:5-10
- God gives commands regarding stopping a fight, how to use weights and measurements in business, 25:11-16
- God commands Israel to remember Amalek's attack as they left Egypt, and commands their utter destruction, 25:17-19

# DEUTERONOMY

## Practical Laws 22-26

- God gives commands about the ceremonial offering of tithes and firstfruits, 26:1-15
- Moses concludes the giving of the Law by calling the people to obey and keep all of the commands and statutes of the LORD that they had been given because they were a people consecrated to God, 26:16-19
