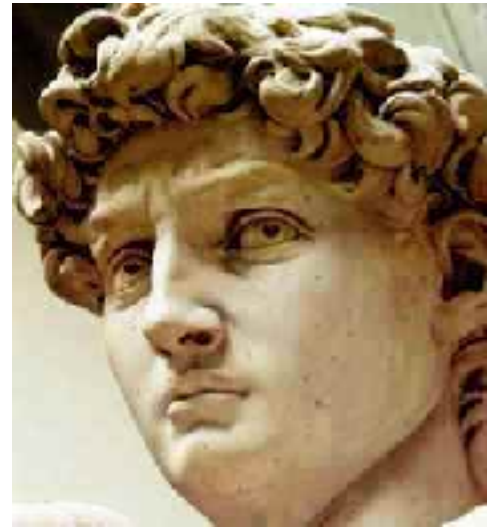


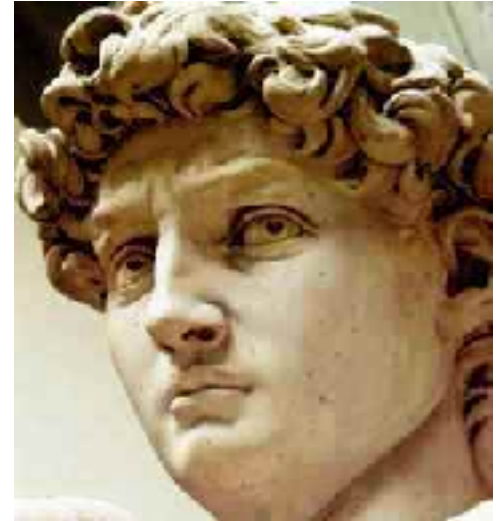
# Errors of David

# Errors of David

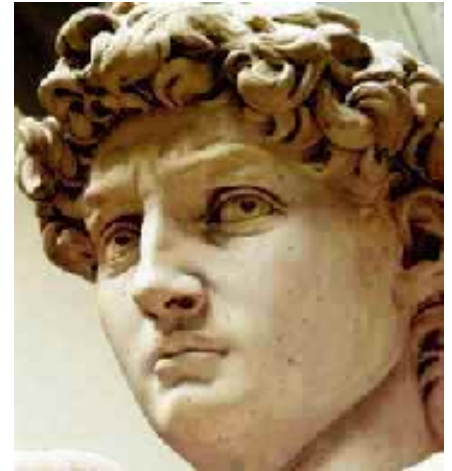
- ❑ Adultery, coveting, and murder  
*2 Sam. 11:1-21*
- ❑ Failed to keep God's proper order  
*1 Chron. 13:1-14; 1 Chron. 15:12,13*
- ❑ Wanted to build a temple for God  
*1 Chron. 17:1-6*
- ❑ Numbered the people  
*1 Chron. 21:1-7*



# Heart of David

## Psalm 51:1-17

- ❑ Acknowledged seriousness of sin  
(Vs. 1,2)
- ❑ Acknowledged his own sin  
(Vs. 3,4)
- ❑ Asked for restoration  
(Vs. 10-12)
- ❑ Acknowledged God's terms of mercy  
(Vs. 16,17)



# Lessons from David

- ❑ We must never do what God forbids
- ❑ We must ask God about the proper order
- ❑ God has a right to tell us what to do
- ❑ All sin has consequences
- ❑ We must acknowledge God's terms of pardon
