

# Who Is A God Like You?

Micah 7:18-19

Asks and  
Answers:  
“Who is a  
God like  
You?”

- Answer: **There is no god like God!** – 1 Sam. 2:1-2; Psa. 89:6-8
- Explains why God is to be the only God before His people – Ex. 20:3-6; 1 Cor. 8:4-6
- To exalt person or thing to be God is to exalt the hopelessly inferior, to bow before a sham.
- We need to grasp this truth and take great confidence, joy, and amazement in it!

Explains **why**  
**there is no**  
**god like God**

- God is nothing like the “gods”!
- **God is like no other because He...**
  - Pardons our iniquities – Mic. 7:18, 9
  - Passes over our rebellion
  - Does not remain angry because He delights in unchanging love – Isa. 13:9; 57:16; Ezek. 33:11
- God’s determination to show grace to sinners defines His glory – Ex. 33:18; 34:5-7

Foreshadows  
**God's saving  
work in  
Jesus Christ**

- Though Israel's sin was severely punished, God's compassion would return – 7:19
  - He would tread down their iniquity – 7:10
  - He would cast their sins into the depths of the sea – Rev. 20:15
- God does not ignore sin – Heb. 2:14-18; 9:27-28

Answers where  
**God's  
pardoning is  
found**

- God pardons the **remnant of His possession** – 7:18
  - That remnant today exists in God's **grace** – Rm. 11:15
  - God's grace is found **in Jesus Christ** – 2 Tim. 1:9; 2:1
  - One comes into Christ **through faith and water baptism** – Rom. 6:3-7; Col. 2:12; Acts 2:38; 22:16; 1 Pet. 3:21
- God pardons His **remnant**, that exists **in grace**, which is found **in Christ**, who is entered **through baptism**.
