PROPER DISCIPLINE IS GODLY DISCIPLINE

GODLY DISCIPLINE REQUIRES...

- Use of God's word to lay down boundaries by instruction, rebuke, chastisement – Prov. 29:17
- Consistently making your child face the consequences of his/her actions.
 - Using punishment
 - Avoiding empty threats
 - Spanking Prov. 13:24; 29:15
 - Beginning early Prov. 19:18; 22:15
 - Not being swayed by the world Prov. 29:17; 23:13-14; Heb. 12:6, 9-11

GODLY DISCIPLINE REQUIRES PARENTAL UNITY

- A child must not be allowed to play one parent against the other
 - Children will try this to get their way
 - It causes lasting damage Eph. 6:1-3; Col. 3:9-10
- Situation must be addressed in unified fashion
 - Showing respect for the other parent
 - Rebuke
 - Unified decision when you learn of differing answers (with the husband having the final say – Eph. 5:22-23)
- Stand together for the good of your child!

GODLY DISCIPLINE REQUIRES PARENTAL TENACITY

- We cannot stop disciplining our children because they reach a certain age
 - As children grow older parents are limited but not powerless in discipline
 - To claim no disciplinary responsibilities because a child is 18 is wrong
- Failing in this area makes parents enablers of their children to live sinful lives — I Sam. 3:13; I Cor. 5:1-2, 5
