Romans 6:16

"Do you not know that when you present yourselves to someone as slaves for obedience, you are slaves of the one whom you obey, either of sin resulting in death, or of obedience resulting in righteousness?

Where Obedience Begins

- With listening to and respecting the one who speaks.
- With humbling our hearts.
- In keeping the commandments.
- Not just hearing, but doing.

How We Are To Obey God

- Very carefully.
- With love in our hearts.
- By keeping all He commands.
- Just as the Lord commanded with no alterations to what He says.

Jesus Personifies Obedience

- John 14:31, "But so that the world may know that I love the Father, I do exactly as the Father commanded Me. Get up, let us go from here."
- Phil. 2:7-8, Jesus "emptied Himself, taking the form of a bond-servant, and being made in the likeness of men. Being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross."

Jesus Personifies Obedience

- Hebrews 5:8-9, "Although He was a Son, He learned obedience from the things which He suffered. And having been made perfect, He became to all those who obey Him the source of eternal salvation."
- Hebrews 2:9, "But we do see Him who was made for a little while lower than the angels, namely, Jesus, because of the suffering of death crowned with glory and honor, so that by the grace of God He might taste death for everyone."
