

THE NEW TESTAMENT CHURCH

Facts we want you to know about the New Testament Church and what we believe:

1. The church was -

- built by Jesus Christ (Matthew 16:13-18).
- purchased by Christ's blood (Acts 20:28).
- built by Christ as its only foundation (1 Corinthians 3:11).
- established on Pentecost after Christ arose from the dead (Mark 9:1; Luke 24:9; Acts 1:8; Acts chapter 2).

2. The New Testament church is called the -

- temple of God (Ephesians 2:21).
- bride of Christ (Ephesians 5:21-32); (Revelation 19:7).
- body of Christ (Colossians 1:24; Ephesians 1:22-23)..
- churches of Christ (Romans 16:16).
- Other names can be found in (Act 20:28; 1 Corinthians 1:2; Colossians 1:13; 1 Timothy 3:15; Hebrews 12:23).

3. Christ himself -

- loved the church. Ephesians 5:25
- bought the church with His blood (Acts 20:28).
- established the church (Matthew 16:18).
- called the church His (Matthew 16:18).
- added people to the church (Acts 2:47).
- is head of the church (Ephesians 1:22-23; 5:23).
- will save the church (Ephesians 5:23).

4. To get into the church you must -

- hear and understand the gospel Acts 8:30-31, 18:8); (Romans 10:17).
- believe in Christ & the gospel (John 8:24; Acts 8:12, 16:30-34).
- repent of your sins (Luke 13:3; Acts 2:38, 3:19, 17:30).
- confess Christ is Lord before others (Matthew 10:32-33; Romans 10:9-10; 1 John 4:14-15).
- be baptized/immersed in water (Mark 16:16; Acts 2:38-41, 8:38, 22:16; 1 Peter 3:21; Galatians 3:27).

5. that through baptism-

- sins are washed away (Acts 22:16).
- you are saved from sins (Mark 16:16); (1 Peter 3:21).
- you have remission of sins and receive the gift of the Holy Spirit (Acts 2:38).
- you get into Christ (Galatians 3:27).
- Christ adds you to the church (Acts 2:37-47).
- you put on Christ (Galatians 3:27).
- you walk in the newness of life (Romans 6:3-5).
- **You obey Christ (Acts 10:48; 2 Thessalonians 1:7-9).**

CHOOSE THE RIGHT WAY

Many people think heaven will be their final dwelling place. This is revealed at funerals when deceased are 'preached into heaven' no matter their sinful life lived, they showed no faith in God, nor were a part of a church family while alive. **Man cannot grant salvation, only God can!**

Jesus said in Matthew 16:18 that He would build His church, and He did. He purchased the church with His own blood (Acts 20:28). Salvation is found in Christ only (Acts 4:12; Colossians 1:13-14). To get into Christ, you must be baptized into Christ (Galatians 3:27). The saved are added to the church by Christ (Acts 2:47).

If you are not a Christian, why are you waiting? Be baptized for the remission of your sins and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. James 4:14 reads, "... you do not know what will happen tomorrow. For what is your life? It is even a vapor that appears for a little time and then vanishes away". Hebrews 9:27 reads, "It is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment."

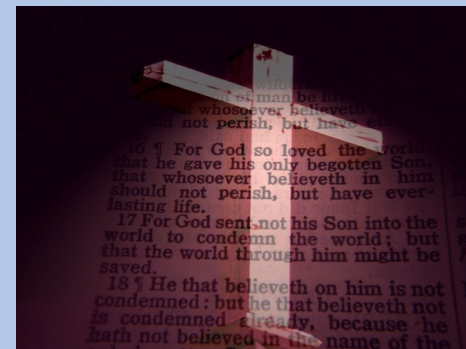

OUR BELIEF

Knowing that people attend church buildings displaying the name, “church of Christ”, not all of them are true worshippers of Christ. "Church of Christ" is *not* the name of a building, rather a description of a body of people who believe the Bible is the word of God and have obeyed God’s plan of salvation and are striving to uphold New Testament principles in the Bible (God’s word).

The name on a building will not save anyone!
The saved are those who do the will of the Father
Matthew 7:21-27!

We believe the ***Bible Is the Inspired Word of God***, 2 Timothy 3:16! Since it is the inspired word of God:

- It does not change (Jude 3; 1 Pet.1:24-25).
- It provides all information pertaining to life and godliness (2 Peter 1:3).
- It will save (James 1:21).
- It will be used in judgment (John 12:48).
- We must not go beyond it (2 John 9).

The Gospel Is the Power of God Unto Salvation.

The gospel is the word of God revealed through Jesus Christ (Romans 1:16-17; Hebrews 1:1-2).

One must:

- Be called by the gospel (2 Thessalonians 2:13-14).
- Believe the gospel (Mark 16:15-16).
- Obey the gospel (2 Thessalonians 1: 8).

This gospel saves (1 Corinthians 15:1, 2).

OUR WORSHIP SERVICE

We strive to follow the spiritual pattern revealed in the New Testament. God said, ‘God is Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth’ (John 4:24). Therefore, you will see simplicity in our worship services led by men.

When we assemble every Lord’s Day (Acts 20:7; Revelation 1:10), which is Sunday, we worship God by:

1. **Praying:** We are led by different men in our congregation (1 Timothy 2:1-8).
2. **Singing:** The whole congregation joins together in praising God in song without the use of musical instruments (Ephesians 5:19; Colossians 3:16).
3. **Taking Communion:** Each Lord’s Day we partake of a memorial feast of unleavened bread and fruit of the vine to commemorate Christ’s death and sacrifice for our sins (Acts 2:42, 20:7; 1 Corinthians 11: 23-26).
4. **Preaching:** We hear a Bible lesson from God’s word that lasts about 30 minutes to exhort, rebuke, and build our faith (Acts 2:42, 20:7; Romans 10:14).
5. **Giving:** Members of this congregation give weekly to the work of the church (1 Corinthians 16:1-2; II Corinthians 9:7). We do not ask or expect our visitors to give.

Our leading men, also referred to as elders, bishops, overseers and presbyters, are men (Acts 20:17, 28; Ephesians 4:11; 1 Timothy 3:2) as are our deacons, (1 Timothy 3:12), evangelists, prayer leaders and song leaders (1 Timothy 2:8). We do not use women in leadership positions (1 Corinthians 14:34).

OUR OBJECTIVE

1. To do the will of God so that heaven can be our home!
2. Preach and teach the word of God so others can know the will of God and be saved! (Matthew 28:18-20, Mark 16:15-16, Romans 10:14-15, Romans 1:16, 2 Timothy 2:2).
