In Him you were also circumcised with the circumcision made without hands, by putting off the body of the sins of the flesh, by the circumcision of Christ, 12 buried with Him in BAPTISM, in which you also were raised **with Him through faith** in the working of God, who raised Him from the dead. 13 And you, being dead in your trespasses and the uncircumcision of your flesh, He has made alive **together with Him, having forgiven you all trespasses**,

Or do you not know that as many of us as were **BAPTIZED into Christ Jesus** were **baptized** into His death? 4 Therefore we were **buried with Him** through **baptism** into death, that just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in **newness of life.**

5 For if we have been united together in the likeness of His death, certainly we also shall be *in the likeness of His* resurrection, 6 knowing this, **that our old man was crucified with Him, that the body of sin might be done away with,** that we should no longer be slaves of sin. 7 For he who has died has been freed from **sin.**

2 Kings 5 Now Naaman, commander of the army of the king of Syria, was a great and honorable man in the eyes of his master, because by him the Lord had given victory to Syria. He was also a mighty man of valor, *but a leper*. 2 And the Syrians had gone out on raids, and had brought back captive a young girl from the land of Israel. She waited on Naaman's wife. 3 Then she said to her mistress, "If only my master *were* with the prophet who *is* in Samaria! For he would **heal** him of his **leprosy**." 4 And *Naaman* went in and told his master, saying, "Thus said the girl who *is* from the land of Israel."

5 Then the king of Syria said, "Go now, and I will send a letter to the king of Israel."

So he departed and took with him ten talents of silver, six thousand *shekels* of gold, and ten changes of clothing. 6 Then he brought the letter to the king of Israel, which said,

Now be advised, when this letter comes to you, that I have sent Naaman my servant to you, that you may **heal** him of his **leprosy**.

7 And it happened, when the king of Israel read the letter, that he tore his clothes and said, “Am I **God**, to **kill** and make **alive**, that this man sends a man to me to **heal** him of his **leprosy**? Therefore please consider, and see how he seeks a quarrel with me.”

8 So it was, when Elisha the man of **God** heard that the king of Israel had torn his clothes, that he sent to the king, saying, “Why have you torn your clothes? Please let him come to me, and he shall know that there is a prophet in Israel.”

9 Then Naaman went with his horses and chariot, and he stood at the door of Elisha’s house. 10 And Elisha sent a messenger to him, saying, “**Go and wash** in the Jordan seven times, and your flesh shall be restored to you, and *you shall be* **clean**.” 11 But Naaman became furious, and went away and said, “Indeed, I said to myself, ‘He will surely come out *to me*, and stand and call on the name of the **Lord** his **God**, and wave his hand over the place, and **heal** the **leprosy**.’ 12 Are not the Abanah and the Pharpar, the rivers of Damascus, better than all the waters of Israel? Could I not **wash** in them and be **clean**?”

So he turned and went away in a rage. 13 And his servants came near and spoke to him, and said, “My father, *if* the prophet had told you *to do* something great, would you not have done *it*? How much more then, when he says to you, ‘**Wash, and be clean**’?” 14 So Naaman went down and dipped seven times in the Jordan, according to the saying of the man of **God**; and his flesh was restored like the flesh of a little child, and he was **clean**.

Mark 16:15

And **Jesus** said to them, “Go into all the world and **preach the gospel** to every creature.

He who **believes and** is **baptized will be saved**; but he who does not believe will be condemned.

Then **Philip** opened his mouth, and beginning at this Scripture, {Isaiah} preached Jesus to him. 36 Now as they went down the road, they came to some water. And the eunuch said, “See, *here is* water. What hinders me from being baptized?”

37 Then Philip said, “If you believe with all your heart, you may.” And he answered and said, “I believe that **Jesus** Christ is the Son of **God**.”

38 **So he commanded the chariot to stand still. And both Philip and the eunuch went down into the water, and he baptized him.**

Arise and be **baptized**, and **wash** away your sins, calling on **the name of** the Lord.’

Then **Paul** said, “John indeed baptized with a baptism of repentance, saying to the people that they should **believe** on **Him** who would come after him, that is, on **Christ Jesus.**”

5 When they heard *this*, they were **baptized** **in the name of** the Lord Jesus.

Acts 2:37

Now when they heard *this*, they were cut to the heart, and said to **Peter** and the rest of the apostles, “Men *and* brethren, **what shall we do?**”

Then **Peter** said to them, “Repent, **and** let **every one** of you be **baptized in the name of Jesus** Christ for the **remission of sins**; and you shall **receive the gift of the Holy Spirit**. 39 For the **promise** is to you and to your children, and to all who are afar off, as many as the Lord our God will call.”

1 Peter 3:21

After being made alive, Jesus went and made proclamation to the imprisoned spirits 20 to those who were disobedient long ago when God waited patiently in the days of Noah while the ark was being built. **In it** only a few people, eight in all, were **saved through water**, 21 and this water symbolizes **baptism that now saves you also**—not the removal of dirt from the body but the pledge of a clear conscience toward God. It saves you by the resurrection of

Jesus Christ,
