# Are you hungry?

- The Israelites were hungry and complained about it, but God provided (Exodus 16:2-4, 35).
- The Manna represented Christ and the spiritual sustenance He would supply (John 6:26-35).
  - *But the Israelites complained about the Manna (Numbers 21:5).*
  - *And the Jews complained about Christ (John 6:41-43).*
- In both cases, they lacked faith and trust in the Provider and in what was provided (John 6:47-52).

*"So we see that they could not enter in because of unbelief" (Heb. 3:19)*



# Are you thirsty?

- The Israelites were thirsty and complained about it, but God provided (Exodus 17:1-7).
- The Israelites serve as a cautionary tale for us today (1 Corinthians 10:1-5).
- Jesus offers the water of life (John 4:10-14).
  - ***The Lion invites us to drink!!!***  
***(John 7:37; Revelation 22:16-17; 5:5; 21:6)***
