  - b. **All the** *qualifications are necessary.* For someone to be a true Holy Spirit appointed elder/shepherd/overseer, he must possess *each qualification*. Either completely (e.g. "the husband of one wife") or to a *significant or mature degree* (such as in "given to hospitality").
- 2. **The timeline will be as follows:** You will have until **Sunday, November 5th**, to turn your forms in. The two nominees will be advised as to the level of support. Nominee's names with sufficient support will be placed before congregation on **November 19<sup>th</sup>**. A period of three weeks will follow for members of the congregation to express any objections or to talk with the nominees from **November 19<sup>th</sup> December 10<sup>th</sup>**. Lord willing, Kirkland will install our new elder(s) on Sunday morning, December **17<sup>th</sup>**.

## QUALIFICATIONS TO BE AN <u>ELDER/SHEPHERD/OVERSEER</u> OF THE LORD'S CHURCH:

God expects members of a local congregation to esteem and honor our elders and to submit to them under Christ as the chief Shepherd, and trust them to give an account for the souls of each member of the church family.

Please give prayerful study of I Tim 3:8-13 and Titus 1: 5-9 as you provide your input.
1. Must be BLAMELESS (not open to accusation, no charge of guilt can be proved against him).
2. HUSBAND OF ONE WIFE (Lit. "A one-woman man").
3. <b>TEMPERATE</b> – (has self-control, mastery over oneself). <b>NOT ADICTED TO WINE</b> (not given to wine).
4. <b>SOBER-MINDED</b> and <b>ORDERLY</b> — (Exercises good judgment, not rash or flippant, of good behavior).
5. GIVEN TO HOSPITALITY – (a lover of guests).
6. <b>APT TO TEACH</b> – (Skilled in the word, able to convince and convict the gainsayer).
7. NO STRIKER (not ready with a blow or quarrelsome), GENTLE (patient). NOT CONTENTIOUS
8. <b>NO LOVER OF MONEY</b> (not covetous, not greedy, or prone to unjust gain).
9. <b>RULETH WELL HIS OWN HOUSE</b> (having faithful, believing children who are in subjection, not accused of riot or unruly).
10. <b>NOT A NOVICE</b> (not newly planted in the faith, not a new convert).
11. <b>GOOD TESTIMONY FROM WITHOUT</b> (good reputation among those that are not Christians).
12. NOT SELF-WILLED (stubborn, headstrong, self-pleasing, or arrogant).
13. NOT SOON ANGRY (not irritable, prone to anger, not a hothead).
14. A LOVER OF GOOD. JUST (fair).
15. <b>HOLY</b> (undefiled by sin, pure, religious, his life is set apart for God's service).
16. HOLDING TO THE FAITHFUL WORD AND A GOOD EXAMPLE TO THE FLOCK (able to take the oversight)
17. <b>VIGILANT</b> (watchful, alert, carefulness to duty).
18. <b>THIS MAN'S WIFE is dignified</b> (honorable), <b>not a slanderer</b> (speaks evil of others), <b>sober</b> (able to control herself, not rash or flippant), <b>faithful in all things</b> (trustworthy).
