#### Introduction:

- A. “You are a chosen generation” (I Peter 2:9).
- B. “You shall be My own possession, a **h**\_\_\_\_\_ nation” (Ex 19:4-6).

#### I. THE IMPORTANCE OF SEPARATENESS.

- A. Many references to **c**\_\_\_\_\_ and unclean (Lev 20:23).
- B. The term holy is mentioned 314 times in reference to the **t**\_\_\_\_\_ and articles of furniture.
- C. There was to be no intermarriage with other nations.
- D. There was to be no **f**\_\_\_\_\_ alliances.
- E. The problem is Israel looked *around* to other nations instead of *up* to God (I Sam 8:19-20).
- F. We are not to touch what is unclean (2 Cor 6:17).

#### II. WHAT IS OUR RELATIONSHIP TO THE WORLD?

- A. To be “in the world, but not *of* the world” (Jn 17:15-6).
- B. We must not **l**\_\_\_\_\_ the world (I Jn 2:15-17).
  - 1. “Set our affections on things above” (Col 3:2).
  - 2. We should not be shocked if the world hates us (I Jn 3:13).
- C. We must not be conformed to this world (Rm 12:2).
  - 1. The battle is in the mind (2 Cor 10:3-5).
  - 2. We are a *new creature* in Christ (2 Cor 5:17).
- D. We must become dead to the world (Eph 2:2).
- E. We must **r**\_\_\_\_\_ the things of the world (Eph 5:11).
