I. SIN WILL TAKE YOU FURTHER THAN YOU WANT TO GO.

- A. **D**_____ became obsessed with protecting his *reputation* and in the process, destroyed his *character*.
- B. "Flee youthful lusts that war against the soul" (2 Tim 2:22).
- C. Don't take sin lightly. It is often like stepping into quick sand.

II. SIN WILL KEEP YOU LONGER THAN YOU WANT TO STAY.

- A. Cain expressed: "My punishment is greater than I can bear" (Gen 4:13).
- B. "If the **c**_____ of sin occurred immediately, there would be few takers."

III. SIN WILL TAKE FROM YOU MORE THAN YOU ARE WILLING TO GIVE.

- A. A perfect example is the prodigal **s**_____ (Lk 15: 11-32).
- B. Sin can make for permanent heart disease, and produce a **h**_____ heart (Heb 3:13).
- C. "What shall a man profit if he gains the whole world and loses his own soul (Matt 16:26)?"

Conclusion:

- A. "**R**_____ the devil and he will flee" (James 4:7).
- B. "Draw nigh unto God and He will draw nigh unto you" (James 4:8).
