II. DON'T FRET.

- A. "On the way, the people lost their patience and complained" (Num 21:4ff).
- B. Don't fret, trust in God's timing.
- C. "Rest in the Lord and wait **p**_____ for Him" (Ps 37:7).
- D. "God makes everything beautiful in His time" (Ecc 3:11).

III. DON'T FAINT.

- A. Jesus said we should "pray always and **f**_____ not" (Lk 18:1).
- B. "Do not become weary in well doing, for at the proper time we will reap a harvest if we do not give up" (Gal 6:9).
- C. "Those who hope in the Lord will **r**_____ their strength" (Isa 40:31).

IV. DON'T FORGET.

- A. "They forgot how many times God showed them His love, and they rebelled at the Red Sea. He saved them as He promised, but they quickly **f**_____ again" (Ps 106:7-8).
- B. "Bless the Lord, and forget not all His benefits" (Ps 103:2).

Conclusion:

- A. "If it seems slow, wait for it, and it will surely come" (Hab 2:3)!
- B. God will bring fulfillment if you don't **fear, fret, faint, or forget** all that God has done for you in the past!
