

HEBREWS 1-4

Throughout the next four classes, we will overview the whole book of Hebrews, grasping its overall message of enduring amidst trials.

Review from Class 1

- Heb. 10:36-39 offer the thesis of the book: calling Christians to endure through faith rather than shrinking back to destruction.
- Heb. 3:7-13 & 10:23-25 offer the means of endurance: mutual, daily exhortation.

Hebrews 1-4

- As we meditate on this section, note the theme of speaking/message/word/& hearing.
- Note the connection between hearing & faith in Heb. 3:7-8.

Questions to Consider:

1. 1:1-4: How has God spoken today?
2. 1:5--2:4: How does the work of angels relate to the message of Christ?
3. 2:5-18: In this section, the author explains the contents of the message, spoken through Christ. What are the contents of this message?
4. 3:1-6: What is the nature of our "calling"? What name has Jesus received?
5. 3:7-19: What happens if we hear yet are hardened?
6. 4:1-10: If we endure through hearing, what will we enter?
7. 4:11-13: How does this section tie together the "message" theme up to this point?
