Major Theme: Hearing the Message/Word of God (1:1-2; 3:7-13; etc.)

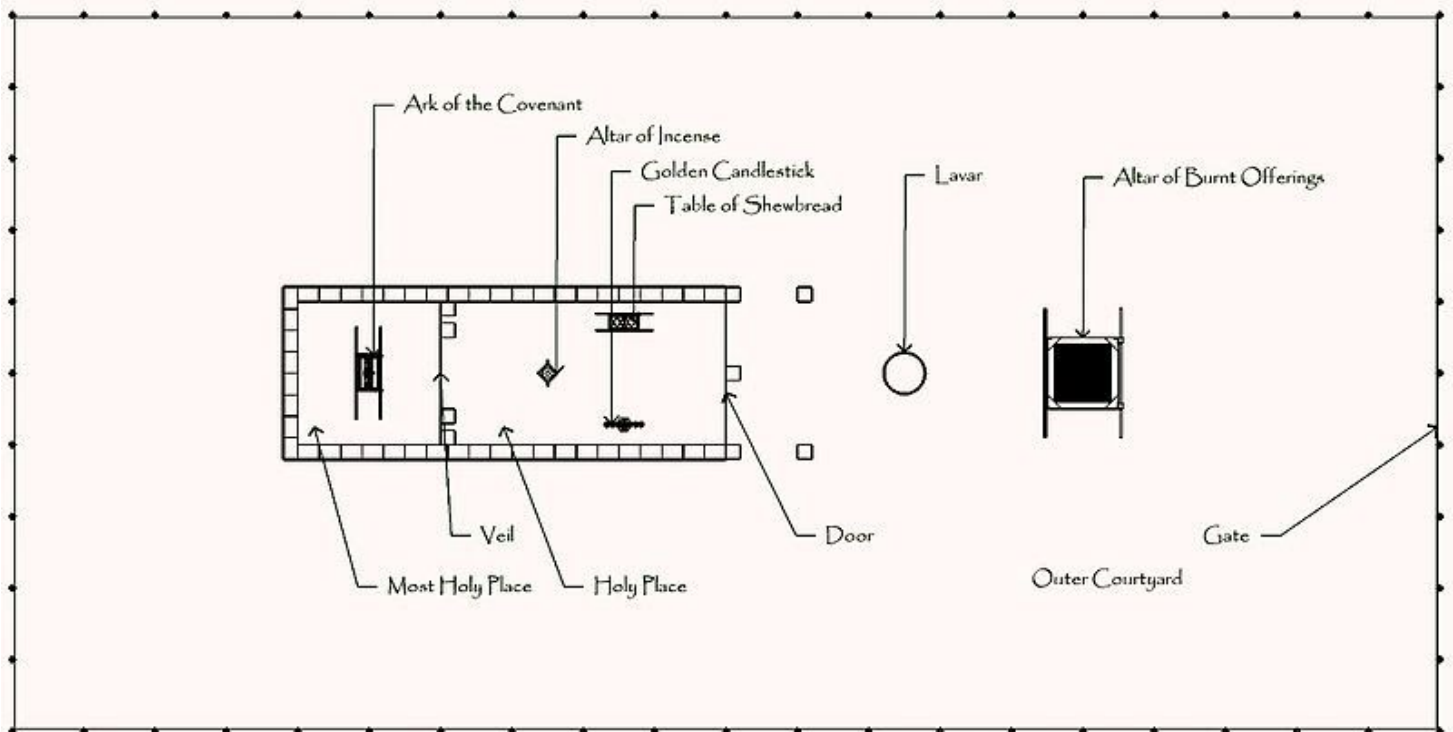

4. Consulting the tabernacle diagram on page 1, which item is out of place in 9:1-5? Why? [Review your Tabernacle class notes for this.]
5. Which day is referred to in 9:5-6? Note, the whole chapter is about this day, so it's really important to understand the OT context here.
6. What is the "present age" of 9:9?
7. What could OT sacrifices not guarantee (9:9-10)?
8. Where did Jesus enter to make His sacrifice (9:11-14)? What role does the Spirit play?
9. What effects have the sacrifice of Jesus had on the Old Covenant and the New Covenant (9:15-22)?
10. What did the blood of Jesus cleanse (9:23-24)?
11. What has the blood of Jesus done to sin (9:25-26)?
12. What will Jesus do at the second coming (9:27-28)?
