- Psalms 119:67-72 Before I was **afflicted I went astray**, but now I keep Your word. You are good and do good; teach me Your statutes. - Psalms 119:74 Those **who fear You** shall see me and rejoice, because **I have hoped in Your word**.
- Psalms 119:79-80 Let those **who fear You turn to me**, that they **may know Your testimonies**. May my heart be blameless in Your statutes, that I may not be put to shame!

- Psalms 119:162-165 I rejoice at Your word like one who finds great spoil. I hate and abhor falsehood, but I love Your law. Seven times a day I praise You for Your righteous rules. Great peace have those who love Your law; nothing can make them stumble.



**Psalms 19:11** Moreover, by them is **Your servant warned**; in keeping them there is great reward.

- Psalms 119:21-22 You rebuke the insolent, accursed ones, **who wander from Your commandments**. Take away from me scorn and contempt, for I have kept Your testimonies.
- Psalms 119:133 **Keep steady my steps** according to Your promise, and let no iniquity get dominion over me.

- Psalms 119:136 My **eyes shed streams of tears**, because people do not keep Your law.
- Psalms 119:139 My **zeal consumes me**, because my foes forget Your words.
- Psalms 119:145 With my whole heart I cry; answer me, O LORD! **I will keep Your statutes**.
- Psalms 119:158 I look at the **faithless with disgust**, because they do not keep Your commands.
- Psalms 119:167-168 My soul keeps your testimonies; **I love them exceedingly**. **I keep** Your precepts and testimonies, for all my ways are before You.
