Acts 17:22-29

²²Then Paul stood in the midst of the Areopagus and said, “Men of Athens, I perceive that in all things you are very religious; ²³for as I was passing through and considering the objects of your worship, I even found an altar with this inscription: TO THE UNKNOWN GOD. Therefore, the One whom you worship without knowing, Him I proclaim to you: ²⁴God, who made the world and everything in it, since He is Lord of heaven and earth, does not dwell in temples made with hands. ²⁵Nor is He worshiped with men’s hands, as though He needed anything, since He gives to all life, breath, and all things. ²⁶And He has made from one blood every nation of men to dwell on all the face of the earth, and has determined their preappointed times and the boundaries of their dwellings, ²⁷so that they should seek the Lord, in the hope that they might grope for Him and find Him, though He is not far from each one of us

- **Jeremiah 32:27** - “Behold, I am the Lord (*Jehovah*), the God (*Elohim*) of all flesh. Is there anything too hard for Me?”
- **Isaiah 40:25-31** - ²⁵“To whom then will you liken Me, or to whom shall I be equal?” says the Holy One. ²⁶Lift up your eyes on high, and see who has created these things, who brings out their host by number; He calls them all by name, by the greatness of His might and the strength of His power; Not one is missing. ²⁷Why do you say, O Jacob, and speak, O Israel: “My way is hidden from the Lord (*Jehovah*), and my just claim is passed over by my God (*Elohim*)”? ²⁸Have you not known? Have you not heard? The everlasting God (*Elohim*), the Lord (*Jehovah*), The Creator of the ends of the earth, neither faints nor is weary. His understanding is unsearchable. ²⁹He gives power to the weak, and to those who have no might He increases strength. ³⁰Even the youths shall faint and be weary, and the young men shall utterly fall, ³¹But those who wait on the Lord shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings like eagles, they shall run and not be weary, they shall walk and not faint.

- **Deuteronomy 8:14-20** - ¹⁴when your heart is lifted up, and you forget the Lord **your God** who brought you out of the land of Egypt, from the house of bondage; ¹⁵who led you through that great and terrible wilderness, in which were fiery serpents and scorpions and thirsty land where there was no water; who brought water for you out of the flinty rock; ¹⁶who fed you in the wilderness with manna, which your fathers did not know, that He might humble you and that He might test you, to do you good in the end - ¹⁷then you say in your heart, ‘My power and the might of my hand have gained me this wealth.’¹⁸And you shall remember the Lord **your God**, for it is He who gives you power to get wealth, that He may establish His covenant which He swore to your fathers, as it is this day. ¹⁹Then it shall be, if you by any means forget the Lord **your God**, and follow other gods, and serve them and worship them, I testify against you this day that you shall surely perish. ²⁰As the nations which the Lord destroys before you, so you shall perish, because you would not be obedient to the voice of the Lord **your God**.

- **Ephesians 2:10** - For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them.
- **2 Corinthians 5:17** - Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new.
