*Song of Solomon 7*





- **Song of Solomon 4:9** - “You have ravished my heart, my sister, my spouse; you have ravished my heart with one look of your eyes, with one link of your necklace.”
- **Revelation 2:5** - Remember therefore from where you have fallen; repent and do the first works
- **Luke 15:17-18** - But when he came to himself, he said, “How many of my father’s hired servants have bread enough and to spare, and I perish with hunger! I will arise and go to my father, and will say to him, ‘Father, I have sinned against heaven and before you, and I am no longer worthy to be called your son. Make me like one of your hired servants.’”



*Remember*



- **Ephesians 4:31-32** - Let all bitterness, wrath, anger, clamor, and evil speaking be put away from you, with all malice. And be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God in Christ forgave you.
- **1 Corinthians 13:5b** - "...thinks no evil"

- **Ephesians 5:33** - Nevertheless let each one of you in particular so love his own wife as himself, and let the wife see that she respects her husband.
