- Spoke to God's people while in captivity
- 3 Major divisions:
 - Chapters 1-24 - The end is coming
 - Chapters 25-32 - Prophecies concerning various nations
 - Chapters 33-48 - There is still hope
- Ezekiel would have a difficult time - Ezekiel 2:3-5; 33:30-33
- He was God's watchman! Ezekiel 3:17-21; 33:1-6
