Titus 2:2-5

By Remembering: You Reap What You Sow!

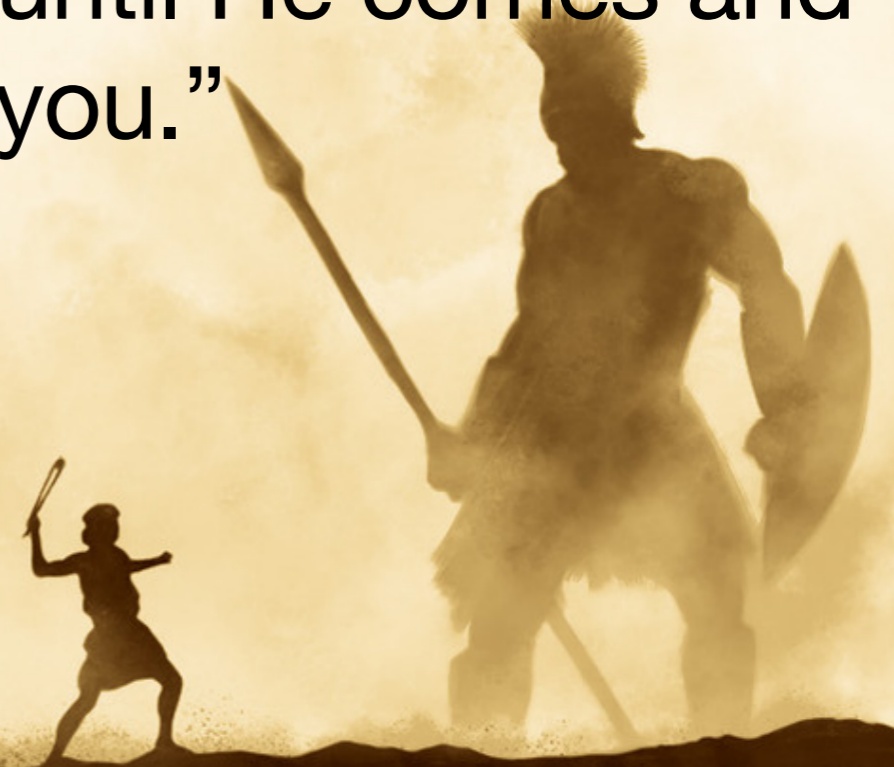
Job 4:8
