Preparing for Something Greater

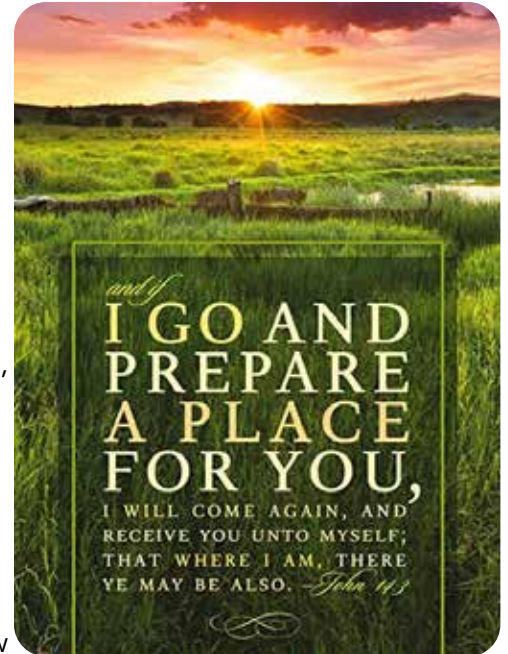

After you make all those decisions, when the time to go on vacation gets close, the preparation continues. From packing bags, making sure the car is ready for a trip. For some, those final preparations mean they are checking and double-checking a list to make sure they do not forget anything. Then the anticipated day arrives, and all those preparations pay off.

We have an even more incredible journey ahead of us, but we do not know the date or time we will make that trip, unlike a vacation. Maybe that is why many do not prepare for the journey that is after this life. We know the date we plan to go out of town to visit that unique destination. His Word instructs us in what we need to do to become a Christian and live a Christian life.

Our heavenly home is prepared for us, as the Lord said, "In my Father's house are many mansions; if it were not so, I would have told you. And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself; that where I am there you may be also." (John 14:2-4)

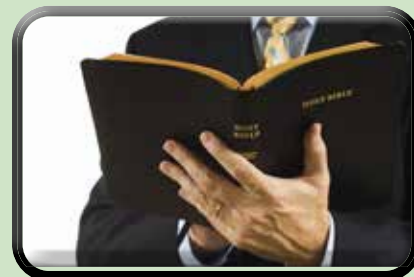
