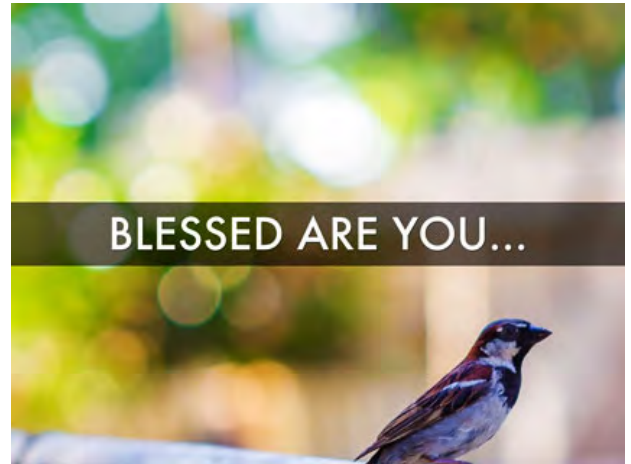

Blessed

If you were to take a glance at Matthew 5:1-12, the one word that reaches out to you is blessed. Blessed are *the poor in spirit, blessed are those who mourn, blessed are the meek, blessed are the merciful*. This scripture takes attributes, some of which we might find less desirable, and in a few short words explains why these are blessings.



Blessed is a word that we seem to use every day. We say a blessing for our food each time we sit down to eat. We tell individuals that they are such a blessing to our lives. We express how blessed we are to have our families, our job, our homes, and the list goes on. Consider the context of the word blessed here in Matthew. Here, the Lord is talking about an attitude of being blessed when life may not be at its best. He is talking about an attitude that should permeate our everyday life. This past year each one of us was affected by the pandemic, some worse than others. I dare say finding a blessing among the challenges of 2020 was not easy. Yet being able to find blessings among the chaos is something that should set Christians apart from the world. Take that a bit farther and consider the words Jesus says at the close of the Sermon on the Mount. "Blessed are you when they revile and persecute you and say all kinds of evil against you falsely for My sake." We may not currently face the open persecution that was experienced by those who were living during the establishment of the New Testament church, although we may, at times, face ridicule for our beliefs. But the Lord says, "Blessed are you when they revile you..." I don't know many that are ready to say they are blessed when they are being persecuted or made fun of by others. Yet, as Christians, we have the opportunity to count it a blessing that God sent His Son so that we have the hope of something much better after this life.

While it is easy to feel blessed when life is providing days of sunshine, it is less so when days of rain arrive. As we continue our journey in life, let us carry the Beatitudes with us. May we remember our blessings even when difficult times come and be an example to the unbeliever. ~PJH

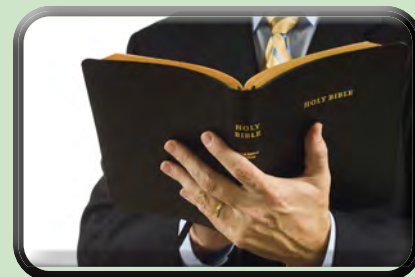
