What can we do for our children?

Parenting is not an easy task, nor is it for the faint at heart. I have never met a perfect parent. I have met those who, before having their own children, felt they knew exactly what to do and had all the answers. I even remember saying, "If that was my kid." But, then the day comes, and we have children, only to realize the truth in the matter.

No two children are alike, and there is no cookie-cutter way to rear children. I say all of this to say that I know I am far from the perfect parent, but I want to share a couple of ideas with you that may help all of us do a little bit better. As I pen these parenting tips, I realize these are all areas that I, likewise, can improve on.

Our children are growing up in a very challenging day and time in our world. On every side, they face temptation along with forces that bring them doubt about their faith, doubts about their beliefs system, and ideology that pull at them to where they have difficulty discerning what is most important. With all the challenges of this world, I think there are three things I want us to consider today. Our children need us to be strong, they need our time, and they need our affection.

Being Strong - Our Children need us to be strong on so many fronts. They need to know we are strong for them, that we stand by them and support them. But they also need us to be strong in the structure and rules we set out in our homes. Some children are inclined to follow the rules, offer few questions, etc. . . but then other children will test on every front to see if the rules will hold true. When that happens, we as parents have to be prepared to be consistent and continue to let our yes be yes and our no be no. (Matthew 5:37)

Time - One of the best gifts we can give our children is our time. More than just our time, our undivided time, which is a challenge when you have the television, computer, smartphones, and so many distractions. Yet, our children need to know that we are here for them, and we hear them. They need to know that they can come to us with anything, and we will listen and try to understand. They also need our time for them to have fun with their parents. We need to give them beautiful memories of time together that they will remember and want to emulate when they become parents.

Love and Affection - Our children need to know they are loved, and they need our affection. I don't think we can tell our children too often that we love them. As they get older, I know they're not too fond of the hugs and kisses, but

they still need them, and they need to know we care. They also need to hear "I love you" and "I'm proud of you." The world is continually putting us down and tearing us apart, and our family should be a place where we can build each other up and encourage each other for good things.

As you go through your week this week, consider what ingredient you need to be a better parent. You may have mastered all the items I have listed but have another area you are working on. Whatever it is, remember the precious opportunity you have to make a difference in your child's life. ~PJH
