The Spiritual Mirror

Mirrors are excellent tools. We use one every day. Looking into a mirror is often one of our first actions of the day. With mirrors, we see details about ourselves that otherwise, we would not know existed.

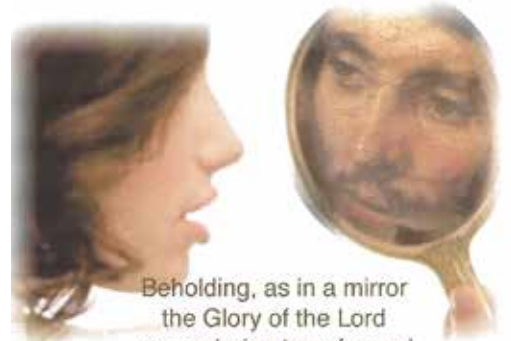
For our physical well-being, mirrors are essential. Without them, who knows what we would look like? But physical mirrors are not the only type of mirrors. There are spiritual mirrors we encounter as well. And they are all around us.

We may not always see them, but they exist and show us a great deal about our spiritual condition. Spiritual mirrors are not ordinary mirrors. They are not a tangible piece of formed glass hanging on a wall. "Spiritual mirrors are people, experiences, challenges, tragedies, etc., that show us our spiritual maturity."¹

James 1:22 -25 points us to the idea that to gain spiritual maturity, we need to consider the reflection of our spiritual life, just as we often think about our physical reflection.

"But be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves. For if anyone is a hearer of the word and not a doer, he is like a man observing his natural face in a mirror; for he observes himself, goes away, and immediately forgets what kind of man he was. But he who looks into the perfect law of liberty and continues in it, and is not a forgetful hearer but a doer of the work, this one will be blessed in what he does."

Our reflection should show a life of action for Christ, a "doer" of The Word. This action word is used several times in this passage, a potent reminder that our faith must be an active faith so that we can continue in the "perfect law of liberty."



Beholding, as in a mirror the Glory of the Lord we are being transformed into the same image - from glory to glory, even as from the Lord, the Holy Spirit!
 II Corinthians 3:18



Take some time this week to examine your life – what is reflected in your spiritual mirror? It may not be so easy, but consider what you may need to change to be a more active worker for the Lord so that the world sees Jesus reflecting in your life. Are you reflecting the Word of God and allowing Jesus to shine through your life? ~PJH
