Being the Salt and Light

What our country needs is some salty Christians!!! "Salt is good, but if the salt loses its flavor, how will you season it? Have salt in yourselves, and have peace with one another." (Mark 9:50)

We often quote the first part of that passage and leave off the latter end. "Have salt in yourselves and have PEACE with one another." When you contemplate those words, you realize that Christ is providing a prescription for peace. You may have heard the adage, "No God, No Peace. Know God, Know Peace," which reminds us that we can only find true peace through God and Christ. We cannot find true peace any other way.

Life has its challenges, and over the past year-and-a-half, we have witnessed how difficulties in life can also result in division. Yet, as Christians, we know that division is not productive. Mark 3:25 says, "And if a house is divided against itself, that house cannot stand." As we see divisions in the world around us, it provides the perfect opportunity for us, as Christians, to stand up, and take this time to teach the world the peace that they can only know through Christ.

As Christians, God instructs us to be a different people, "But ye are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a peculiar people; that ye should shew forth the praises of him who hath called you out of darkness into his marvelous light." (1 Peter 2:9 KJV) Being a different person also means that we look for ways to show love and obtain peace. To have peace, we need to pay attention to what we allow our minds to dwell on. We also must consider how we treat our fellow man. Philippians 4:4-9 can help direct us "Rejoice in the Lord always. Again I will say, rejoice! Let your gentleness be known to all men. The Lord is at hand. Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God; and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus. Finally, brethren, whatever things are true, whatever things are noble, whatever things are just, whatever things are pure, whatever things are lovely, whatever things are of good report, if there is any virtue and if there is anything praiseworthy—meditate on these things. The things which you learned and received and heard and saw in me, these do, and the God of peace will be with you."

Christians, now is our time to be the salt and the light for the Lord in this world. How we work together with each other and work with folks outside of Christ shows the world who we are and, more importantly, Who's we are because the only way we truly can make a difference is by being different from the world. How will we make a difference if we act like the world in our





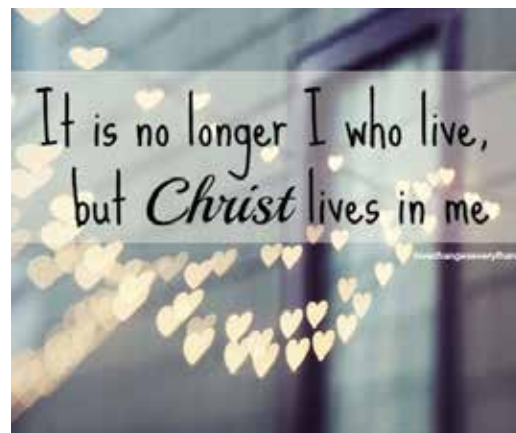

actions and how we handle our tongue? Saying with our lips that we are Christians is simple but living the Christian life is much harder to accomplish. Because being a Christian means that we are living for Jesus and not ourselves. Galatians 2:20 states, "I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me."

By inspiration in Romans 12:9-16, Paul teaches us how to behave like Christians "Let love be without hypocrisy. Abhor what is evil. Cling to what is good. Be kindly affectionate to one another with brotherly love, in honor giving preference to one another; not lagging in diligence, fervent in spirit, serving the Lord; rejoicing in hope, patient in tribulation, continuing steadfastly in prayer; distributing to the needs of the saints, given to hospitality. Bless those who persecute you; bless and do not curse. Rejoice with those who rejoice, and weep with those who weep. Be of the same mind toward one another. Do not set your mind on high things, but associate with the humble. Do not be wise in your own opinion." Repay no one evil for evil. Have regard for good things in the sight of all men. If it is possible, as much as depends on you, live peaceably with all men. Beloved, do not avenge yourselves, but rather give place to wrath; for it is written, "Vengeance is Mine, I will repay," says the Lord. Therefore "If your enemy is hungry, feed him; If he is thirsty, give him a drink; For in so doing you will heap coals of fire on his head." Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good."

May we learn true divine love and peace. May Jesus continue to permeate our lives as we seek His teachings by example on how to live and to love. ~P.J. Hicks
