Titus 2:11-14; Heb. 8:12

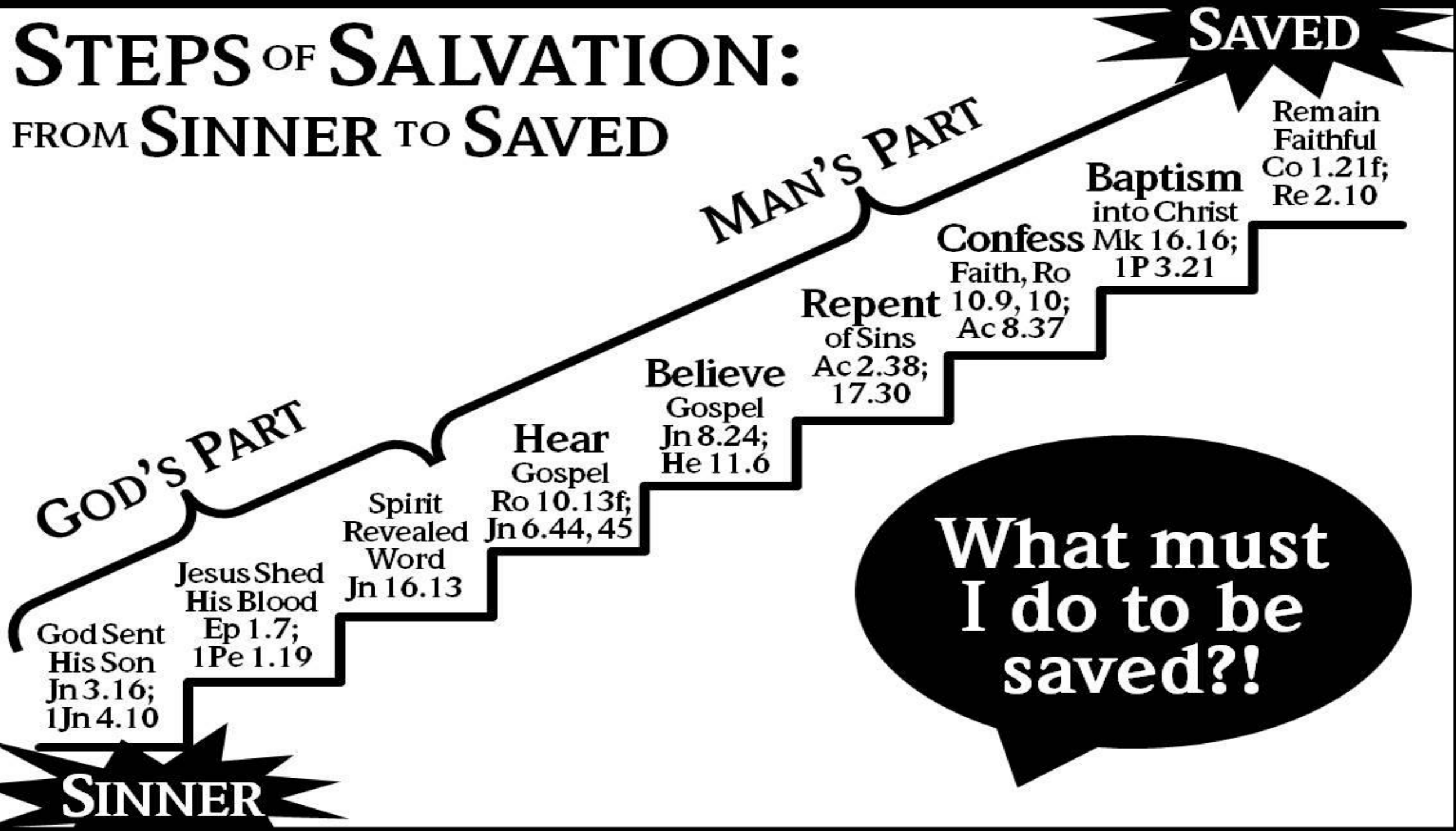
A Peculiar People
